

Appendix K User Question and Action Summary

The table below summarises the questions asked (Q), examinations performed (E), investigations requested (I), and management actions selected (M) by each of the users, as they relate to the actions anticipated by the author (see Section 6.3.2.4 on page 161). Items that were selected by the user are marked in grey. (1) indicates that this item was selected in the first consultation. (2+) indicates that this item was selected in the second or later consultation. Those investigations undertaken in the first consultation are usually performed with the intent of diagnosing a problem, or to establish a baseline for future monitoring. Those investigations undertaken in the subsequent consultations are usually undertaken to monitor the patient. This might be done to assess the response to treatment, or to detect adverse reactions. Note, this table only includes those options that are most directly related to the desired diagnostic and management goals. For example, one could have checked for myalgia by asking about side-effects related to the medication. The preferred way was to check the serum creatine kinase activity. Therefore, only this investigation is included in the table below.
